Recent Awards

The Waco Symphony Council has won numerous awards from the Texas Association for Symphony Orchestras. TASO has awarded the WSC two commended awards for the Belle and Brass Program and for the Pillow Raffle. The 2005 Symphony Showhouse was a winner in fundraising for TASO.

The Celebrity Conductor's Contest-2004—was a Silver Medal Winner for fundraising for the American Symphony Orchestra League at the National Convention in Los Angeles in May 2005. This award was a first for the WSC.

Waco Symphony Council

The Waco Symphony Council, established in 1962, supports the Waco Symphony Orchestra in many ways. It provides scholarships to Baylor music students, sponsors concerts each year, and endows the Waco Symphony Conductor's Chair, which is funded through the Waco Symphony Foundation. The Council provided furnishings for the Music Director's office in the Glenis McCrary Music Building. In Waco Hall, the Council also provided new percussion instruments, the conductor's podium, and cello chairs. The Council also makes arrangements for the Patron Party and provides refreshments at Sunday Sounds concerts. The Council publishes a newsletter which provide its members with information about the Orchestra and the activities of the Council. The Waco Symphony Council sponsors the Symphony Belle program for sophomore and junior girls, and the Symphony Brass program for junior boys. The Youth Program, sponsored by the Council, includes support for the Waco Symphony Youth Orchestra, the Boys and Girls Choirs and the Children's Concert.
